Description of indicator	Implementation of trained clinical personnel to deliver psychological and/or psychosocial interventions and ensure that these interventions are offered to all mothers admitted to mother and baby units.
Numerator	All mothers admitted with their babies (excluding women admitted in pregnancy).
Denominator	All mothers admitted with their babies.
Rationale for inclusion	Maternal mental illness can result in adverse outcomes and affect the mother-baby relationship with subsequent long-term impacts, particularly for the child's development. As such ensuring mothers and their infant's develop strong attachment during the first year of life is crucial.

Frequency of data collection	Quarterly

Frequency of reporting to commissioner	Twice annually for numbers of staff trained. Quarterly for psychosocial interventions offered to all mothers admitted.
