Mobiles are available to patients across the trust including in medium secure hospitals(where patients are provided mobile phones purchased by the hospital), the trust makes mobile phones available for patients to use where ever feasible and safe for patients.

However the Trust does have a Blanket restriction policy on specific wards which is applied at times based on assessed security needs of the patients in the interest of patient safety. This is discussed and agreed by the MDT Team. For further details of the Blanket Restriction Policy please see the attachment.

We also have an Internet Access for Service Users Policy, which has elements of the use of mobile devices within inpatient settings. For further details please see attachment.
